




QuantERA Initiative (2016-2021)

NCN – Narodowe Centrum Nauki: a government agency set up in 2011, supervised by the Polish Ministry of Science and Higher Education.


- Financing the best projects in the area of basic research
- Supporting researchers starting their career (no less than 20% of NCN resources) and aiming to establish new research teams
- Vigorous international cooperation programme
- 2015 Budget: **222 M**€

Selected statistics for 2014:

- 12 announced and 12 concluded calls
- ca. 12 000 proposals submitted
- 1804 proposals qualified for funding = 16 % success rate
- 6482 external reviewers, including 4035 foreign reviewers (62%)
